Missouri Vocational Rehabilitation Program

Mary Jo Worthington (right) spoke to members today about the Missouri Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) program.

The mission of VR is "empowering people with disabilities through employment." Mary Jo shared that up to 1 in 4 adults in the U.S. has some type of disability. The most common disability involves difficulties in the cognition area. It was noted that many disabilities are "invisible" (i.e., chronic fatigue, post-traumatic stress, depression).



VR works with individuals through counseling, job searches, and training to help them gain employment. Employers receive a qualified candidate who generally has a better attendance record and a higher retention rate than normally seen.

Two resources she spoke about included:

- ➤ The Job Accommodation Network (https://askjan.org/index.cfm) is the leading source of free, expert, and confidential guidance on job accommodations and disability employment issues. One way to use this resource is with the A to Z search function. You can look up any disability along with information about suggested accommodations, things to consider, and other tips.
- The Employer Assistance and Resource Network on Disability Inclusion (EARN) (https://askearn.org/) offers information and resources to help organizations of all sizes recruit, hire, retain, and advance people with disabilities. Tips are posted to help businesses get started as an inclusive and accessible workplace.
